Hedon Group Practice has been involved in Research studies since 2012. We wish to thank all our patients who have participated in various studies in this time as you have helped us to become the most active research Practice in the Hull & East Riding locality.

Since March 2015 we have joined forces with Church View Surgery to form a Cluster where we envisage that we will be able to share our resources and enable wider patient participation in certain studies.

Ongoing Studies

Gloria AF- This observational study aims to follow any newly diagnosed patient with atrial fibrillation whether they are on treatment or not.

CANDID- Are you over the age of 35 with a complaint of any chest symptoms (e.g cough , short of breath, wheeze)? Or do you have any bowel symptoms (abdominal pain, constipation , diarrhoea, feeling tired all the time) ?

If so please contact the research team as this study (from Southampton University) aims to explore predictors for cancer.

Early Arthritis- This study from Leeds is looking at anybody over the age of 16 with a musculoskeletal complaint (i.e joint pain , aching muscles) or a first degree relative of anyone who has a diagnosis of Rheumatoid Arthritis

Intense- This International study is exploring the effects of sugar control in patients with Type 2 Diabetes who have had their treatment “intensified” with an injectable therapy. Monthly searches are run to identify such patients who are then invited to participate

TWICS- This study based at Castle Hill Hospital is looking at patients with COPD who are given a drug called Theophylline to see if it prevents hospital admissions.
